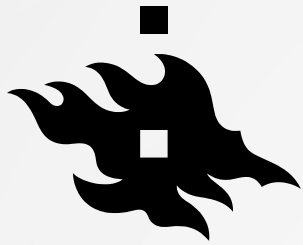

Orientation week

Teacher tutoring

According to teacher tutor document. Meeting with the tutor teacher (30 min per student one-on-one). Students can book a private or group guidance appointment with the teacher tutor throughout studies.

EduCafé

Informal forum organized throughout the year for CE students and staff to discuss topics of interest, including optional studies, traineeships, employment after graduation, etc.

HowUlearn Questionnaire

The HowUlearn questionnaire on learning and teaching is designed to support students with information and feedback. The questionnaire also collects student responses to help plan and develop the University's teaching.

Support and help for writing your Master's thesis.

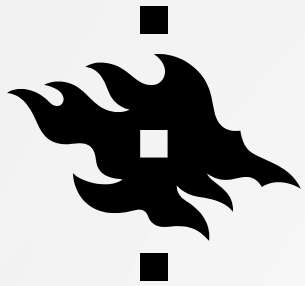

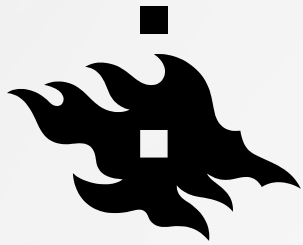
