

ParAs Degree structure 2020 – 2023

Your degree includes:

90-120 credits of advanced courses in the Master's programme

The amount of compulsory and optional advanced studies is different with each study track:

Advanced studies in the Study Track in Astrophysical Sciences include:

50 credits of compulsory advanced studies (35 credits of studies common to both study tracks and a 15 credit compulsory core package)

40-70 credits of optional advanced studies

Advanced studies in the Study Track in Particle Physics and Cosmology include:

40-45 credits of compulsory advanced studies (35 credits of studies common to both study tracks and a 5-10 credits compulsory core package)

45-80 credits of optional advanced studies

The optional advanced studies can include whole course packages or individual courses related to your field of interest and as agreed in your personal study plan.

0-30 credits of other courses from your Master's programme or other programmes

Other studies may include study modules or individual courses from other degree programmes to meet the minimum total number of credits required for your degree. Also practical training and language studies can be included.
